## Costume and Performance Info

Costume and performance fees are due 12/1/11. Prices are as follows:

**Costume fees:** \$45.00 - Predance, Ballet 1,2, Tap 1,2                      \$60.00 - All other classes  
**Performance fee:** \$20/student      Family max \$40

We strive to select age appropriate, quality costumes. You may pay extra each month if the fall to be applied to costume and performance fees. For costumes added after 12/1/11, a \$15 late order fee will be charged. Additional shipping fees may be necessary. If your child does not wish to be in the performance, EADS must receive written notification by December 1. If a student withdraws for any reason or chooses not to perform in the performance after costumes have been ordered, EADS will attempt to cancel the costume order if you wish. A cancellation fee of \$15 will be deducted from each costume payment.

## Dress Code

Dance is a disciplined art form and must be respected as such. In order to be taught effectively, see proper body alignment, and make necessary corrections, the dancer must be dressed properly.

**Changing into appropriate dance clothes is required.**

**Any shoe that has been worn outside may NOT be worn on the dance floor.**

**Hair:** Hair must be securely off face in a bun or pulled off the face by a hair band or barrettes if short.

**Predance:** Pink leotard, pink tights and pink ballet slippers. Skirts may be worn the last class of the month.

**Ballet:** Black leotard, pink tights, pink slippers. Skirts at teachers discretion. Capezio or Bloch brand shoes only.

Split sole slippers are highly recommended for Ballet 4-6.

**Modern:** Leotard, tights or leggings, bare feet.

**Tap:** Leotard and tights, bike shorts or leggings, t-shirts. Black tap shoes. Capezio or Bloch brand only.

**Step Dance:** Full leotard, tights or leggings. Black ghillies.

**Jazz:** Full leotard, tights, leggings or jazz pants. NO BARE BELLIES. Black jazz shoes (no dance sneakers).

**HipHop:** Same as jazz. Dance sneakers recommended.

**Clogging:** Leotard, tights, black tap shoes.

**All Boys:** White tee, jazz pants, bike shorts, tights or sweatpants. Black dance shoes.

**Please mark all shoes and dance wear with your child's name or initials. Thank you.**

## Code of Conduct

EADS provides an environment that is supportive, encouraging and conducive to learning. We want all of our students to have an enriching experience. Students will be respectful of their teachers, their classmates and themselves.
