 - **Masks are required for students and audience members.**
 - There is **no health check requirement for audience members.**
- We are asking that everyone attending the performance **PLEASE PARK IN THE CIVIC CENTER PARKING GARAGE on the east side of the building.**
- **We have very limited numbers of audience and there will be plenty of parking in the city garage.**
 - **This will leave parking across the street and behind the building for Civic Center staff and volunteers who must check-in at the back of the building.**
 - **Reduce traffic at the back where we have students checking in**
- Please help us to minimize the number of people waiting at student check-in. **Only one parent or guardian should bring students age 10 and under to the check-in location on the walk along the 20th street side of the Civic Center.**
- **Please leave family and friends to wait near the main entrance to keep the number of people waiting at student check-in as low as possible.**
- **Parents or guardians must leave the exterior back-stage area after checking their students in for the performance.**
- Audience members will go to the front of the building for instructions on which entrance to use.
- All tickets have a portal number which indicates the entrance that must be used for the ticket holder to reach their seat.
