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## General Performance Information

- Our **Spring Performance** is held each June and is **optional**.
- En Avant does not hold a “recital”, instead we stage **professional productions** that:
  - Benefit local non-profit organizations
  - Give dancers a chance to learn from participating in a real theater production
  - Celebrate students’ skills with family, friends, and our community
- Every student is encouraged to join—even our youngest and newest dancers.
- **Students who do not perform remain in class and learn the class piece and may act as alternates up until rehearsals.**

## Attendance

- Once you choose to perform, please keep track of all **rehearsals, photo sessions, and performance times**.
- If your child is sick, please keep them home.
- Let spring coaches know dance should remain a priority, so your student gets the most from class and rehearsal time.
- If your child must miss class, **please log the absence in the Parent Portal**.
- Some classes may receive videos to practice with at home (note: videos do not replace rehearsal with the group).
- If injured, students may still attend class to watch and learn.
- Please notify us right away if your child cannot perform so we can adjust choreography.
- Students with unpaid fees (tuition or costume) and no payment plan will not be allowed to participate.

## Attendance Requirements

- Some classes may set **minimum attendance** to protect dancer safety.
- Participation is at the discretion of teachers and the studio director.
- Students with inconsistent attendance may be denied the opportunity to perform, even if costumes are purchased.
- **No refunds on costumes or performance fees.**

## Performance Volunteers

- Volunteers help keep classes safe during performances.
- **Volunteers may be parents, grandparents, or adult family friends.** No siblings under age 16.
- Please **sign up early—we need:**
  - **16 volunteers for the afternoon show**
  - **12 volunteers for the evening show**

- **Duties include:**
  - Sitting with classes in the balcony during the performance
  - Ensuring dancers remain seated with their group
  - Watching doorways and keeping dancers out of the lobbies
  - A few may help as ushers before the performance
  - A few may supervise students in the pick-up area after the shows

- **Volunteers do not need a ticket; they watch from the balcony.**
- All volunteers enter through the drop off door on 20<sup>th</sup> St.
- Sign up by phone, email, or in person at the office during store hours.
- You may serve at more than one performance if you'd like.
- **If you cannot serve after signing up, please notify us as soon as possible.**
- Updates are shared in the monthly newsletter.

## Performance Fee, Tickets & Other Details

- **Two Spring Performances** are held in partnership with Black Dog Rescue, Inc. and co-sponsored by the Cheyenne Civic Center.
- **Participation is optional** and not required for class enrollment.
- Families should consider carefully—there are additional requirements and costs.

## Additional Performance Costs

- \$20 performance fee per student – due **Nov. 1**
- Costume fee per dance (see page – due **Nov. 1**)
- Shoes and/or tights as needed
- Optional class and/ or individual and/or performance photos – May /June
- Tickets purchased through the **Cheyenne Civic Center** only:
  - **Website:** [cheyenrepresents.com](http://cheyenrepresents.com)
  - Be cautious of third-party sites (higher ticket prices)
  - **Discounted family packages available if purchased by March 14, 2026 with En Avant code (emailed to all student families in November)**
  - All ticketing questions go through the Civic Center—not En Avant
  - **Double-check which performance your child is in before purchasing tickets**

## About Rehearsal Weeks

- All rehearsals before Dress Rehearsal are held in **Studio 2** (large upstairs studio, 313 ½ W. 18th St.).
- Classes run **shorter (30 minutes in Week 1, 20 minutes in Week 2)** so each group can run performance dances several times.
- **Rehearsal schedules differ from regular class times** – please take note.
- Students must wear costumes during:
  - **Week 1** (for photos in Studio 3) on a different day than regular classes.
  - **Dress Rehearsal** at the Civic Center (Thursday, June 11).

## Class & Individual Photographs

- Photos are taken during **Week 1 (June 1-3)** on a day separate from rehearsals.
- Students only need to wear costumes for:
  - Class photo day in Week 1.
  - Dress Rehearsal (June 11).
- Please arrive **on time, fully dressed and ready** for photos.
- Class photo schedule is below.

## Dress Rehearsal

- **Thursday, June 11 – 4:00 p.m.** at the Civic Center
- Afternoon performers rehearse first, followed by evening performers
- Parents may watch; students may leave once their dance is finished

## Performances

### Saturday, June 13 – Cheyenne Civic Center

- **Afternoon Performance – 2:00 p.m.** (students arrive 1:30 p.m.)
  - Classes: Pre-dance, Tot Tumbling, Tot Hop, Tot Cheer, Parent Tot, Tap 1, Beg/Inter Jazz, Beg/Inter Hip-Hop, Ballet 1 & 2, Mixed level Hip Hop, Cheer 1, Contemporary 1
  - Runtime ~1.5 hours, no intermission.

- **Evening Performance - 6:00 p.m.** (arrive 5:30 p.m.)
  - Classes: Ballet 3-7 & Pointe, PL Ballet, Intermediate/Adv Hip-Hop , Adult Hip Hop, All Lyra/Aerial Hoop, Irish, Tap 3, Adult Tap, Tap 2 & 3, Adult Ballet, Adult Burlesque, Contemporary 2 & 3, Musical Theatre Jazz, Intermediate/ Adv Jazz , Acro, Cheer 2
  - Runtime ~2.5 hours with 20-minute intermission.
- Families with dancers in both shows may choose to have their student perform in just one if needed.
- Parents with dancers in both shows may choose to volunteer as a balcony monitor for one show to avoid the need for purchasing tickets for two shows.

## Costumes

- Students may perform with as many or as few classes as they choose.
- Costumes are only required for the dances in which they perform.

## Costs

- Pre-Dance, Tot Hop, Tot Cheer, Tumbling, Ballet 1 & 2, Tap 1 & 2, Jazz 1 → \$85 each
- All other classes→\$100 each
- Costumes must be **paid in full by Nov. 1.**
  - Not ordered until full payment received
- Costumes not paid by Nov. 1:
  - Additional \$40 fee
  - Not ordered until full payment received
- Costumes are custom made to order—late orders may not arrive in time.
- No refunds on costumes for any reason (injury, withdrawal, move, etc.).

## Ordering & Fitting Costumes

- Measurements are taken in class each November.
- Sizes vary—parents may need to make simple alterations.
- Easier to take in than let out.
- Costumes cannot be returned or exchanged.
- Families moving out of state before delivery will pay extra shipping.
- Costume preview boards posted in studios each April.
- Costumes handed out mid- to late May.

## When Costumes Are Worn

- For photos - June 1-3)
- For Dress Rehearsal (June 11)
- For the Performance (June 13)
- After the performance, costumes are yours to keep!

## Caring for Costumes

- **Do not wear costumes before rehearsals or performance.**
- Costumes are fragile—treat them gently.
- To fix loose ribbons, sequins, etc.:
  - Use fabric glue or simple hand stitching
- To remove wrinkles:
  - **Steam only** (never iron—fabric may melt)
- To store:
  - Use breathable containers (pillowcase)
  - Avoid plastic bags (trap odor, moisture, cause fading)
- Do not wash costumes before performance.
- Spot clean gently if absolutely necessary.
  - Test any cleaner on hidden fabric first
  - Dawn + hydrogen peroxide mix can work on stains
- **Never use a dryer.**
- After the performance:
  - Safest to hand-wash in cold water
  - Gentle cycle with garment bag may work but is risky
  - Always hang to dry

## Shoes & Tights

- Never wear dance shoes outdoors.
  - Carry shoes in, wear street shoes with easy slip-off
  - Outdoor debris can damage soles and the stage floor

## Required Shoes

- Ballet (Girls) → Pink ballet shoes   Ballet (Boys) → Black ballet shoes
- Contemporary → Bare feet or tan half-shoes
- Hip Hop → Dance sneakers/clean indoor tennis shoes
- Hoop → Bare feet
- Irish → Black jazz shoes, ghillies, or hard shoes
- Jazz → Black jazz shoes
- Pre-Dance (Girls) → Pink ballet shoes (no slippers)
- Pre-Dance (Boys) → Black ballet shoes
- Pointe → Pink pointe shoes
- Tap → Black tap shoes

**Tights** – Colors for each class will be in newsletters closer to the performance.

## Hair & Makeup

- **No bangs** – they shadow the face.
- **Only wear the headpiece/flower/ribbon** that comes with the costume.
- **Bun basics:**
  - Start with a tight ponytail.
  - Twist hair until it curls around; secure with bobby pins.
  - Wrap an **invisible hair net** around bun (available at The Dancer's Bag).
  - Twist net and pull over bun repeatedly until snug.
  - Add more pins as needed – it doesn't have to be perfect!
- **Dirty hair works best** for buns.
- **Make-up:** Eyeshadow, blush, lipstick, mascara (if you wish).
- **No glitter** in hair, on body, or on face – this is a safety issue (it can fall off and make the floor slippery).
- **Girls:** No underpants under costumes.

## **Drop-off & Pick-up (Dress Rehearsal & Performance)**

- **Location:** Cheyenne Civic Center, 510 W. 20th St.
- **Parking:** Park in Civic Center lot (east of building on 20th St).
  - No parking in staff lot at 20th & O'Neil.
- **Drop-off:** Students dropped on **south side of Civic Center along 20th St.**
- **Dress Rehearsal (Thu, June 11):**
  - Students may leave after their final dance.
  - Parents may wait in the balcony (enter through Portal 1, next to drop-off door).
  - Pick-up is at the same south side door.
- **Performance (Sat, June 13):**
  - Drop students at same south side door.
  - Students must stay through the entire performance.
  - Pick-up at same location after performance.
  - Everyone else (not dancing) must enter through **front doors** for ticket scanning.

## **Expectations for Students**

- **Costumes:** Wear your full costume for your first dance. Bring other costumes in a labeled garment bag.
- **Dancers remain backstage or seated with classes for the entire performance.**
- Not allowed:
  - In the auditorium before, during, or at intermission.
  - Being picked up in stairwells or at intermission.
- **Pick-up:** Students released only at south side door on O'Neil Ave.

## **Expectations for Audience**

- Our spring performance is a **professional-level production** with a length typical of other staged shows.
- Please stay for the entire performance to support all dancers.
- If you must leave, do so quietly—better to exit than distract others with phones, talking, or moving around.
- **Phones:** Turn off and put away. Light is as distracting as sound.
- Sit near doors if you need frequent breaks. Enter/exit only between pieces.
- **Treat this like live theater:**
  - Don't talk during dances.
  - Remain seated until house lights come up at the end.
- Thank you for helping make this a positive experience for every dancer and family.

## Photographs & Video

- Photos and video **are allowed** if **no flash** is used.
- Please don't block others' view.
- **Copyright & child safety:** Do not post images online that include children other than your own.
- En Avant is not responsible for any violations.

## Choreography

- Choreography is the **intellectual property** of En Avant and the teacher who created it.
- It may not be reproduced or sold without permission.
- Teachers retain ownership of their choreography after the spring performance.

## After the Performance

- **Dancers may not re-enter the backstage area after the show ends.**
  - Any personal items left backstage will be removed by Civic Center staff, placed in the back hallway, and later returned to En Avant Studio.
- All parents, siblings, friends, and guests must **exit through the front doors** of the Civic Center.
  - Please leave the auditorium and lobby quickly so Civic Center staff can begin cleanup and prepare for the next event.
- **Pick-up for dancers is on the south side along 20th St.**, same location as drop-off.
  - Parents may wait outside the backstage door.
  - **Only dancers may enter or exit through the backstage entrances (20th St. backstage door or the O'Neil Ave. staff parking lot door).**
- Dressing rooms will close and lock **30 minutes after the performance ends.**
  - Costumes and personal items left behind will be placed in the hallway.
  - Any **unclaimed items will be taken back to En Avant.**
