Hip Hop Ages 6 & up

Fun and funky this class will explore different styles of street dance.

Pre-Dance Ages 3-6

This class teaches basic ballet steps, concentrating on coordination and motor skills, rhythm and musicality, and free dance.

Ballet Ages 6-10

This class focuses on traditional basic ballet curriculum teaching correct technique, proper alignment and terminology.

Lyra (Aerial Hoop) Ages 9 & up

This class is for previous Lyra students that want to stay in shape over the summer. Class will focus basic Lyra moves and includes core and upper body work and conditioning to increase strength and flexibility for work on the aerial hoop.

Tot Hop Ages 3-K

Class where we will focus on age-appropriate high energy hip-hop class for our youngest dancers. Class focus is on strength, coordination, and rhythm., as well as keeping students entertained while learning beginning hip-hop skills and moves.

Contemporary Ages 9 & up

Jazz/Ballet Fusion technique that challenges dancers to use emotion to interpret music through dance movement.

Ballet Ages 10 & up

This class teaches traditional ballet curriculum teaching correct technique, proper alignment and terminology. Dancers with previous pointe experience can wear their pointe shoes, to help stay in peak shape over the summer.
